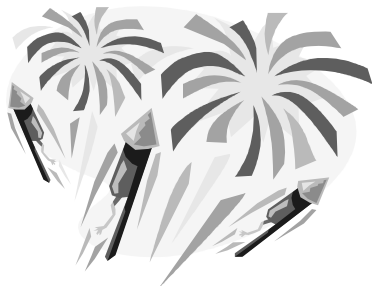

## Current Projects

**Newsletter:** The newsletter will now be emailed to residents who provide an address to reduce costs. Residents who would prefer a paper copy should contact Kathy at 359-0283.

**Gym/Clubhouse:** A gas grill has been donated for use at the clubhouse during private parties and neighborhood events. The HOA states that the grill may be used “at your own risk”. Gym renovations and new equipment purchases are currently on hold until the fall.

**Pool:** The pool opens for the season on Saturday, May 26th at noon! A new pool management company, Northwest Pool Management, will be staffing and maintaining our pool this year. The lifeguards are Red Cross certified and will wear uniforms.

The 2007 pool hours are posted



in the clubhouse. There are reduced hours while school is still in session. It will be closed for cleaning on Mondays except for Memorial Day and Labor Day. The pool may be rented for private parties outside of regular pool hours (mornings, Mondays, or after 8 pm). A fee of \$25 per hour includes lifeguards.

The “baby pool” is reserved for children ages 5 years and younger only. Private swim lessons may be available through the management company.

**Safety:** Two of our neighborhood “**Slow, children playing**” signs were stolen from their posts at the curve on Auburn Meadows Drive. Our HOA dues will pay to replace the signs. If you see anyone tampering with or taking any of our signs, please contact the OKC police department.



The pond fountain is currently not in operation due to a problem with the power source (the electrical box is located under the existing water level and blowing fuses). Residents and their pets are advised not to play in or around the pond where the cables connect the fountain to the electrical source. There is a *risk of electrocution* if the wires are exposed. The wires run through a conduit buried in the mud. The electrical box will be relocated when the water level recedes.

**Thank you** to the OKC police department for noticeably increasing speed and stop sign enforcement along 182nd Street.
